Martha's Way

Three locations (MAM, Sharpstown and Virtual)

Martha's Way has served a total of 26 clients in 2023.

- 92% of the 2023 participants graduated.
- 96% of are employed.
- 100% of graduates took Basic Computers and Basic Microsoft, an add on to the training.
- 84% participate in our English as a Second Language (ESL) class.
- 26 job leads have been referred to our clients.
- Workshop on April 26th, *Aid to Victims of Domestic Violence*.

Professional Home Caregiver Training

We have had 13 clients graduate from our Professional Home Caregiver Training Program in 2023.

- 100% of the graduates took Basic Computers and Microsoft Basic.
- 19% were Spanish-bilingual.
- 35.71% are in the 18-39 age range.
- The next class will start on May 8th, 2023,
- We currently have 21 registered students.
- Professional Caregiver Manager position is currently vacant.
- Our goal is to pilot a Spanish Professional Caregiver Program by the end of the year.
