Christian Community Service Center is a nonprofit coalition of 42 churches, volunteers and donors serving the poor, hungry, disabled and otherwise needy while respecting their religious, ethnic or cultural differences.

BASIC NEEDS

10,396 5-day food packages distributed

6,595 pounds of fresh produce harvested from the CCSC Garden

609 households received rent assistance

96% of surveyed rent assistance clients reported they maintained their residence or improved their living condition



71 households received utility bill assistance

95% of surveyed utility assistance clients reported they avoided utility disconnection



2,790 Clothing Pantry visits



282 people received financial assistance with prescriptions, dental services or eyewear/eye exams

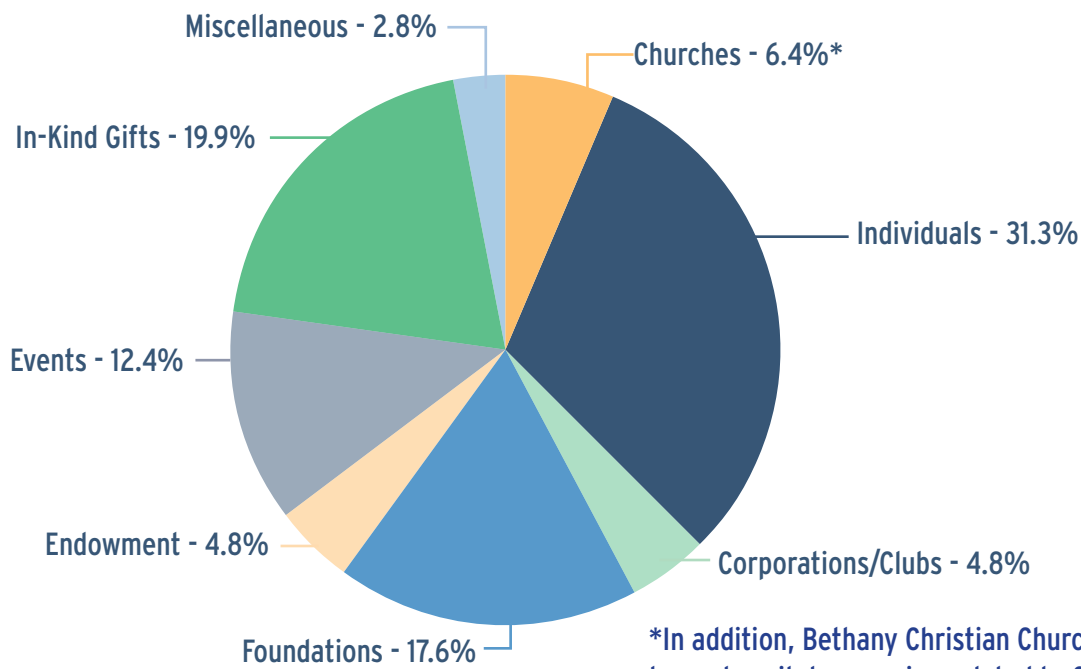
